



How to build a MY HERO Film Page

1. REGISTER

Register at myhero.com/register.

The registration page asks for information such as name, location and email address. This information will not be given to any third party. Students may use a school contact or email address, rather than their own personal email, in the requested field.

2. Log in to myhero.com in upper-right corner and then click on Create New Page, which will open myhero.com/create.

4. Creating a Film Page

Next, you have two options, either paste a link to your video that is already online on YouTube or Vimeo into the Paste Film Link field, or Click on the Upload button and upload an .mp4 or .mov file of your video that is under 50 MB. Wait for the upload to complete before clicking next.



7. Add Images that relate to your film, a film still or thumbnail, by clicking add images.




8. Preview the page to see how it looks and decide if it is ready. You can go back to fix things before submitting.

9. Click on FINISH (bottom right corner) and SUBMIT (middle of page) to submit your film for review by MY HERO staff. Once your film has been approved we will notify you by email when your page is activated.
